



Software Development Quality Assurance



Quality Assurance (QA) is a way of ensuring that products and services do what they are supposed to do and meet certain quality criteria. The Year Up training primarily focuses on quality assurance for software and hardware products.

Skills Gained

Through Year Up's training, you will:

- Gain an understanding of databases and their role within organizations
- Learn about the software development lifecycle (SDLC) and how QA fits into it
- Gain an understanding of testing processes
- Practice writing test cases using testing tools and following testing protocols

What to Expect

In QA internships, students work with teams to first understand what a software or hardware product is supposed to do and then test it against those specifications. Some internships will require manual testing, which means that you would identify issues by trying the product yourself and looking specifically for problems. In other internships, you would automate your tests, meaning you would program a tool to identify issues for you. Students in these roles then carefully document any problems found.
